



Welcome to Year 3

Hello!

Hello everyone and welcome to year three. To help establish our routines and clear expectations, I have provided some important information about our class systems.

PE - Wednesday (all afternoon)

Please send your child into school in a plain white t-shirt and black bottoms. This could be shorts, leggings or joggers for when the weather gets colder. The red Moor End hoody also forms part of our PE uniform and we would like to see the children wearing this on **Wednesday only**. Please arrive to school dressed and ready for PE in PE uniform. Earrings must be removed by parents prior to the lesson.

Reading Books - Monday and Thursday (exchange days)

Books will be changed on each day. Red tokens will be given for each read. Please record if your child has read and record any comments in the reading log, so we know if books need changing and to check for any issues. Passcodes and log-in details are in the front of the book for Spelling Shed and TT Rock Stars.

Spellings - Friday

Spelling test day is Wednesday. Children will be provided with a yellow spelling book and returned each Wednesday. The books will contain their new spellings and they will bring it home to practise. Scores will be recorded in the back of the book.

Spelling Shed, TT Rock Stars & Read Theory

In Key Stage 2 we use online websites to practise Spellings, Reading Comprehension and Times Tables. Children will be asked to practise at home and log in details will be stuck in the front of the yellow home reading books. Each week we shall check the leader boards. Frequent users will be rewarded with red tokens.

Snack— Children may bring in fruit or vegetables for breaktime. No cereal bars or biscuits, these treats are for home.

Red Tokens — Behaviour, manners and excellent school work

Individual efforts will be rewarded through the house point system. Children will receive red tokens for: great work, super manners, showing kindness, following the school rules and upholding our school values. Teams will race to the final to fill their box with tokens. Once full, the winning team will receive a special reward such as non-uniform day, extra playtime, hot chocolate or a treat.

Golden Tickets—Continued excellent behaviour in all aspects

Each half term teachers and staff will choose a 'Golden Ticket Winner'. This is a very special award for children who have excelled in all areas for a continued period of time. Ticket winners are taken out for an afternoon of bowling with a burger & fries or a trip to the cinema.'
